

Driving Directions

PRINT these out old school style as there will not be cell phone service after Willits. **Your GPS will NOT work.** It is approximately 3.5 hrs to Dos Rios from the Bay Area. There can be traffic – especially if you leave during rush hour. So give yourself time and take snacks. ☺

Please arrive on the land during the registration time, 12-3pm on Friday Aug 29. If you know that you have to arrive outside of this window, please email us (dancemissiontheater@yahoo.com). We do not recommend that people arrive after the sun sets. It is no fun to set up tents in the dark and people have been known to miss exits. Because of this, we ask that people arrive no later than 8:30pm on Friday. If it looks like you will not be able to do this, we recommend staying in a hotel in Willits and then arriving Saturday am early. Please call us at **707-983-6977** when you are leaving Willits and/or Laytonville (depending on your direction) if you are arriving outside the registration window so that we can have someone at the front gate to greet you.

FROM THE BAY AREA

* Take 101 North

* Note: You will pass through Willits on 101 North. Willits is the last place that you will have cell phone service. You can buy snacks in Willits, fill up with gas etc. The property is about 40 minutes away from Willits. **If you are arriving outside of the registration period (12-3pm on Friday), you MUST call us at 707-983-6977 so that we can meet you at the gate.**

* **Make a right on CA 162 E**, and stay right. (Turn off is approximately 12.5 mi from Willits. You will pass a rest stop on your left and the 162 exit will be shortly after on your right. If you get to the town of Laytonville, you have gone 10mi too far.)

* **Make a left onto Dos Rios Road** (Approximately 15 mi after the CA 162 turn off. You will go over a bridge, and then you will immediately see a sign that says “Dos Rios Road, ½ mi”. Make this left.)

* The road splits. Follow the signs for Dos Rios Road – which means **take the low road**, the road on the left.

* You will pass through the “town” of Dos Rios (“town” is an enclave of about 10 houses).

* The road become gravel / unpaved. Continue on this road for about 1/2 - 3/4 mi.

* **10501 Dos Rios Road will be on your left.** Make sure you see the sign for 10501. Do NOT go down any driveways unless you see 10501!

FROM HUMBOLDT

* **Take 101 South**

* Note: You will pass through the town of Laytonville (Laytonville will be the last time that you have cell phone service. You can get gas and snacks here. The property is about 30 min from Laytonville).

* **Make a left on CA 162 E** and follow 162 to the right. (Turn off is approximately 10mi from Laytonville. If you get to Willits, you have gone 12 mi too far.)

* Follow the same directions to **Dos Rios Road** as above in the “From the Bay Area” section...
